Snacks and lunch during training	Snacks will be provided during coffee breaks on workshop days.  Lunch will usually be provided during training days (although on some occasions a packed lunch may be provided or participants will have lunch at the NARC cafeteria).
Domestic Travel costs	For those coming from outside Islamabad or Rawalpindi Bus, train, and private car are options for travel to Islamabad. Participants will be reimbursed for preapproved and agreed costs based on submission of official receipts. Please plan to arrive the night before the first day of the workshop and keep your travel receipts in order to obtain reimbursement.  For those coming from Islamabad or Rawalpindi Such travel
	costs are to be covered by the Per diem provided.











#### Per Diem Allowances

For those coming from <u>outside</u> Islamabad or Rawalpindi Per diems are all based on pre-approved travel and workshop schedules. The Per Diem allowance (which excludes accommodation & breakfast, as this will be paid directly by AIP) is as follows:


- Travel days. The equivalent of \$12.50 per travel day in Pakistan Rupees (Rs). Note: Per Diem will be paid only upon presentation of the incoming boarding passes or travel documents.

- Workshop days. The equivalent in Pakistan Rupees (Rs) of \$25 per day for each workshop day.

## For those coming <u>from</u> Islamabad or Rawalpindi

The Per Diem allowance is as follows:
